## Computer 2nd-4th Grade

Pocket Folder

## Library K-4th Grade

K Boys- one box of crayons

K Girls- one box of tissues

1st grade - one glue stick

2nd grade - one box of markers

3rd grade - one box of colored pencils

4th grade - girls: one pencil

4th grade - boys: one eraser

## Physical Education K-4th Grades

Reminder that all students need to wear athletic shoes (tennis shoes) with socks.

Leggings or shorts are required under skirts and jumpers

## Music K-1st Grade

One box of 24 crayons and two number 2 pencils – Please dump into a sandwich Ziploc bag with their name and teacher's name on it. This will be left in the music room.

## Music 2nd Grade

One box of 24 crayons and two number 2 pencils- Please dump into a sandwich Ziploc bag with their name and teacher's name on it. One 3 prong folder with pockets just for music-

Please put their name, teacher's name, and "Music" in large black letters on the front

## Music 3rd-4th Grade

One 3 prong folder with pockets to be used just for music.

Please put their name, teacher's name, and "Music" in large black letters on the front of the folder

Two number 2 pencils in a Ziploc bag with their name and their teacher's name on it.

## Kindergarten - Please label all supplies with your child's name (except pencils and glue sticks)

2 24 count boxes of Crayola crayons

6 Triconderoga triangular, #2 soft pencils (can be ordered from Amazon or Walmart)

12 pack - Crayola erasable colored pencils

6 glue sticks

1 pair of children's scissors (not safety scissors and not sharp-pointed)

1 hard plastic pencil box (5x8 - no larger please)

2 large erasers

3 thin line black dry erase marker

1 box 200 ct. tissues

2 sturdy plastic folders- 3 pronged (please put your child's name on all folders)

1 sturdy plastic pocket folders

1 pair of headphones for i-Pads (not earbuds)

1 container of Clorox or Lysol wipes

1 container of anti-bacterial wet wipes (face/hands)

1 yellow highlighter

1 adult sized sock (for dry erase board)

1 Kindermat- 1 inch-no thicker, please (they're typically red and blue)

1 backpack-please refrain from dragons, witches, Harry Potter, Pokemon or violence related (No wheel backpacks)

Girls: sandwich or quart size zipper baggies

Boys: gallon size zipper baggies

Please do not send any supplies not on the list

## **First Grade**

- 1 book bag (labeled with child's name)
- 1 set of headphones or earbuds (labeled with child's name)
- 1 plastic 8 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{8}$ " supply box (labeled with child's name) Please do not send in zip-up or metal supply boxes.
- 2 of the 24 count boxes of Crayola Crayons (labeled with child's name)
- 1 10 pack of Crayola classic fine line washable markers (the skinny ones, labeled with child's name)
- 1 pair child size scissors (labeled with child's name)
- 1 of the plastic 2 pocket folders with prongs, any color (labeled with child's name)
- 1 of the plastic 2 pocket folder with prongs, RED in color (labeled with child's name)
- 2 rubber erasers (like the pink pearls, but any brand is okay. Labeled with child's name)

The rest will be shared as a class so we don't need names on them:

- 4 fine tip (skinny) black dry erase markers to share
- 6 glue sticks to share
- 1 black sock (we use them to erase our dry erase boards)
- 1 pack (10 or more) of Ticonderoga brand pencils to share
- 2 boxes of tissues to share
- Boys only- 1 box of Gallon size zip top bags.
- Girls only- 1 box of Sandwich size zip top bags.

## **Second Grade**

- 30 #2 sharpened pencils (additional pencils to be sent in each quarter)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 12-24 glue sticks
- 1 package of lined note cards
- 1 box crayons (at least 24)
- 1-2 large erasers
- 1 small supply box (5X8) or pouch
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 ruler with inch and centimeter markings that does not fold up
- 1 package of 24 crayola pencils
- 1 NIV (Children's Adventure, if possible) Bible
- 4 dry erase markers - any color
- Girls: 1 box gallon sized bags
- Boys: 1 box quart sized bags
- Backpack to come to school daily with no wheels
- 1 pair of headphones (no earbuds, they fall out)
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 sturdy pocket folder
- 2 canisters of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 box Crayola markers washable
- 1 package of wide ruled paper
- 2 70 ct wide ruled spiral notebooks
- 1 blue or white 1 inch, clear front pocket, three ring binder for daily STAR binder
- 1 personal pencil sharpener for colored pencils
- 1 sock for dry eraser

1 pair of scissors (small school size)  
1 ruler with inch and centimeter markings (flexible or bendable only please)  
2 large boxes of tissues  
1 NIV Adventure Bible for 3rd & 4th grades  
6 glue sticks  
7 pocket folders (5 solid colors-red, green, blue, purple, orange for class + 2 for specials)  
1 package of multi-colored dry erase markers  
1 pair of earbuds to plug into computers and i-Pads (no headphones)  
1 composition notebook (100 sheets)  
100 index cards - no lines please  
Girls- Sandwich baggies  
Boys- Snack baggies

1 pkg. #2 pencils (NO mechanical pencils)  
1 red pen  
1 pkg. of 24 crayons  
1 pkg. of 8 markers  
1 pkg. of 12 colored pencils  
1 pkg. highlighters (different colors)  
1 black Sharpie  
2 composition notebooks (100 sheets each)  
1 pair of scissors (right or left-handed as needed)  
6 glue sticks  
2 boxes of tissues  
1 large eraser  
1 pair of ear buds  
1 flexible ruler  
1 zippered pencil pouch (no boxes)  
1 sturdy plastic folder (for homework)  
NIV Adventure Bible  
Girls: 1 box of gallon-sized baggies  
Boys: 1 box of sandwich-sized baggies
